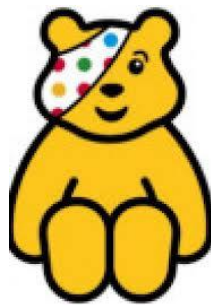


FREE SCHOOL MEALS
