CLASS TEACHERS

We would be grateful if when you would like to talk to your child's teacher this is done by making an appointment via the office. Staff are always willing to talk to you regarding concerns or issues with your child but in order to ensure that teachers are available please ask the office to make an appointment for you by giving them some available times and a brief outline of the issue so that relevant information can be shared with you

at the meeting. Any messages that need to be given to teachers such as forgotten homework, PE kits, reading books etc. can be made by sending a text message to the office or dropping in a note or speaking to a member of office staff in person. We

want you to be able to talk to staff regarding concerns with your child but sometimes it is not possible for staff to talk to you immediately due to other concerns.

We realise that for Robins class there will often be informal conversations that need to take place at the end of the school day. Please could we ask that

you allow the staff to dismiss all the children before you have a conversation with Robins staff.



NEW BUILD

We are now into the new building and are in the process of setting up the school. There is still building work to be completed both inside school and in the outdoor areas. Hopefully this will be finished in a few weeks' time. Thank you for your patience with us regarding entry into school and going home arrangements. As you can appreciate

CONSENT FORMS & CONTACT DETAILS

We would be grateful if you could return the consent form and contact details to the office at your earliest convenience. Once completed you will not have to print off and return consent forms for visits and clubs. This will mean that office staff will not have to "chase" people who have forgotten to fill in the form and you won't have to search for a letter or ask for a new one when it has been lost. In order to be more efficient, correspondence will be, whenever possible, via e-mail and text messages so please ensure that we have the correct information from you so you don't miss information.

TOAST CLUB

Will be starting on Monday. Children need to be signed in/sign in at the office. They will need to go straight to the hall by themselves taking all their belongings with them and not going to their classroom first.
