Dear parents and carers,

Our children continue to inspire and delight with their enthusiasm and love of learning. The improvements in children's progress and achievement are shown in recently published results where All Saints children did much better in 2022 in reading, writing and maths and phonics than the National Average. In particular 83% of the children in EYFS (Reception) achieved the Early Learning Goal at All Saints compared to 66% Nationally. Phonics results were also much better at All Saints with 89% passing compared to 75% Nationally. All the results can be found on our school website.

As we approach remembrance day we do so with thanks to all those who gave so much to give us all the freedoms our children and families enjoy today.
