Literacy

- Writing simple sentences about colour and art
- Reading non-fiction texts about art and artists
- Retelling familiar narratives
- Reading and writing tricky words.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Discussing right from wrong and considering the perspectives of others
- Reading *The Colour Monster* and talking about feelings – what might our facial expressions look like, what makes you feel happy, sad or angry.
- Reading "The Dot" – discussing positive self-talk and being kind to ourselves and each other.



Religious Education

- Why do Christians put a cross in an Easter garden?
- What do Christians believe happened to Jesus?



Communication and Language

- Learning the names of different feelings and ways to describe those feelings.
- Listening and responding to each other.
- Use talk to discuss their learning, their likes and their dislikes.



Understanding the World

- Learning about colour in nature
- Making observations about the changes in the seasons
- Finding out about how art has changed over time.
- Learning about the places in the world the different artists we are learning about are from.



Expressive Arts and Design

- Recreating art in the style of the artists we are learning about:
Yayoi Kusama, Matisse, Kandinsky, Mondrian, Jackson Pollack and Andy Warhol
- Exploring colour mixing
- Listening to music as we create art, exploring the link between music and emotions.
